



The February meeting program was about hand tools. Don Peterson and Tim DuBois put together a program that included a discussion and hand out for a basic hand tool kit, and several demonstration benches with an emphasis on planes.

After a quick run through of the basic hand tool kit everyone was able to try out the various planes, shooting boards, and saws.



- Jointer and Fore planes—wooden, transitional, Stanley Bailey, and Lie Nielsen.
- Smoothing planes—wooden coffin ,Krenov style, Stanley Bailey, and Lie Nielsen.
- Joinery planes—Wooden moving filister plane, router planes, Stanley 45 combination planes.
- Rabbet planes

 wooden, Lee Valley, Stanley
- Molding planes-Wooden side bead, wooden hollows and rounds.
- Several shooting boards including a flat 45, donkey ear 45 degree, 90 degree straight.
- Stanley 358 miter box.
- Various bench hooks and stops as well as a bench on bench.

Introduction to Basic Woodworking Class started Tuesday March 6

12 students are building a keepsake box over the course of three lessons. Mark Voigt, pictured to the right, is the instructor.

The first class included lessons on shop safety, wood selection, safe use of the jointer, table saw, and chop saw. Everyone completed cutting the miter joints for the box sides and all boxes were glued up by the end of night one.

The next class will include lessons on using the router table to cut splines into the miter joints and begin assembly of the interior parts.

Thanks to Shawn Jarvis, Don Peterson, and Mike Ross for acting as helpers during the class.
