Secretary

Duties include taking notes at the monthly club board meetings and other special board of director meetings (such as the annual Expo), compiling and disseminating those notes to the board members. The time commitment varies, but 4 hours a month should cover the job.



Marketing Director

Duties include working with the CMWA board on preparing marketing materials for such activities as the Wood Expo, as well as recruiting new advertisers and staying in contact with current advertisers. It also involves working with the treasurer to bill advertisers. The monthly time commitment varies from ~2 to 4 hours most of the year, but up to 8 hours a month in the spring when preparing for the Expo.

This position involves compiling the monthly newsletter and emailing it to the website manager. The time commitment averages about 3 hours a month.
